### **Resort Amenities and Activities**

Dragon Cay Resort is your home base for a variety of experiences, on and off the property. From miles of cliffside hiking trails, ancient cave exploring, kayaking, low-key local cuisine, beach hopping, zero-pollution stargazing and more. Middle Caicos is an adventure traveler's dream.

**Kayaking & Paddle Boarding:** extensive network of inland waterways in Middle Caicos, plus Bottle Creek on North Caicos. Dragon Cay Resort has a kayak for guest use.

**Hiking & Biking:** Dragon Cay Resort sits immediately adjacent to one of the world's most striking coastal hikes, Crossing Place Trail as well as to the stunning Indian Cave. The nearby Conch Bar Caves is the largest non-submerged cave system in the Bahamas-Turks and Caicos Island chain and is a Turks and Caicos national park. Dragon Cay offers guests the use of our fat tire bikes for fun exploring.

**Fishing:** The Turks & Caicos Islands offer world renowned bonefishing, shore fishing, & sea fishing, North & Middle Caicos are no exception.

**Snorkeling:** Three Mary Cays, and Conch Bar Beach all have abundant marine life to be discovered. Snorkeling gear is available for complimentary rental at Dragon Cay Resort.

### **Dining**

## **North & Middle Caicos**

Dragon Cay Resort is located on the island of Middle Caicos in the Turks & Caicos Island, the largest and most remote of the islands. Middle Caicos is connected to North Caicos via a Causeway and thus are often spoken about as one island. Staying in Middle Caicos can be the trip of a lifetime, an unparalleled adventure or a relaxing soul healing experience. We know you will love your stay here so long as you understand the experience you are embarking on, as Dragon Cay Resort is a one-of-a-kind vacation.

Mudjin Harbor, and much of Middle & North Caicos, is highly preserved, and void of any major developments or modifications to the natural environment. When you come here, you will experience the Caribbean in its truest form. There are no major grocery stores, developments, or tourism companies on the island. You will often be alone at the beaches and sites or accompanied by a minimal number of fellow guests. Many people describe the experience as much like a private island getaway, without the high costs.

## **Getting Here**

To get to Dragon Cay Resort, you will need to take a taxi from the airport to the Heaving Down Rock Marina (also known as Walkin Marina) in Leeward, Providenciales, which is about a 20-minute taxi ride not including a stop at the grocery store, which we recommend while still on Providenciales (IGA Grocery Store). There are a few grocery stores in North Caicos. Grocery stores in Middle Caicos are scarce and have much more limited options.

The ferry cost to North Caicos is \$70.00 round trip or \$40.00 each way (subject to change).

If your flight arrives after 3 pm, you may need to overnight on Providenciales before continuing to Dragon Cay Resort. Our staff will be happy to help you with additional hotel reservations.(These times changes. Should we just direct them to the website for timing)?
